## THE DECLARATION

OF

HELPING HANDS INC. HUMANITARIAN ALL NATIONS DIPLOMATIC MISSION  
(HHIDM)

Established 01/2000

In alignment with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations (1961), which outlines the legal framework for the recognition of diplomatic missions, HHIDM is fully recognized as a diplomatic mission and legal entity through bilateral treaties with sovereign nations. HHIDM has met the necessary criteria for recognition under international law, securing our status as a self-governing body in accordance with the Vienna Convention.

Pursuant to Article 2 of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations (1961), HHIDM has been recognized by the required number of nations through bilateral treaties, affirming its status as a legal diplomatic entity under international law.

HHIDM, as a fully established diplomatic mission, has entered into bilateral treaties with sovereign nations, including provisions of full diplomatic immunity.

In accordance with international law and mutual agreements, the details of these treaties remain confidential until formally announced to the global community.

We, the founding cabinet members of Helping Hands Inc. Humanitarian All Nations Diplomatic Mission (HHIDM), proudly present this Declaration of our Diplomatic Mission. HHIDM was established upon the Constitution and the three universal truths, with the goal of providing humanitarian service for humanity. This Declaration is rooted in the principles of Unlimited Compassion, Unlimited Loving Kindness, Sympathetic Joy, and Equanimity, which we seek to embody and extend to all beings without discrimination.

In alignment with these virtues, our Constitution has been carefully crafted to reflect the Laws of Nature, which govern all life and guide us toward a path of peace and sustainability. The three fundamental Laws of Nature that form the basis of our Constitution are:

### 1. The Law of Impermanence

Everything in life is subject to change. Nothing remains constant, and understanding this truth helps us embrace the flow of life, adapt to its challenges, and grow with the knowledge that everything is temporary. We acknowledge that each moment offers an opportunity to serve our commitment to humanity.

### 2. The Law of Unsatisfactoriness

The nature of worldly existence is inherently unsatisfactory. True fulfillment cannot be found in material gain, fleeting pleasures, or external circumstances. Recognizing this truth, we prioritize inner peace, selfless service, and the well-being of others as our path to true happiness.

### 3. The Law of Non-Substance

All phenomena lack a permanent, independent essence. By recognizing this, HHIDM is dedicated to fostering a sense of unity, cooperation, and mutual support across all nations and peoples, understanding that everything is impermanent and interconnected.

Through this Declaration, HHIDM pledges to uphold these natural laws and virtues in all our actions, policies, and implementations. Our mission is to serve humanity with humility, promote global peace, alleviate suffering, and protect

the environment. We are committed to creating a sustainable future, fostering goodwill, and respecting the diversity of cultures and beliefs worldwide.

In addition to the Constitution and the three universal laws, HHIDM upholds the following core values:

1. Global Peace and Non-Violence

We strive to resolve conflicts non-violently and promote peaceful coexistence among all nations.

2. Humanitarian Service

We are dedicated to providing humanitarian aid and fostering compassion for all, regardless of differences.

3. Sustainability and Environmental Stewardship

HHIDM is committed to promoting eco-friendly and sustainable practices in all our projects.

4. Cultural Restoration and Respect

We value the restoration of cultural heritage and promote respect and understanding between communities.

5. Education and Health for All

We advocate for accessible education and holistic health, integrating both alternative and conventional medicine.

6. We stand as a diplomatic mission for Humanity and Global Peace, bound by our Constitution and the universal truths that guide us in our efforts to serve, uplift, and unify all of humanity.

Confidentiality and Disclosure Clause

While HHIDM maintains the confidentiality of all bilateral treaties and diplomatic agreements, it acknowledges that disclosure may be necessary in specific circumstances, such as establishing financial accounts. In accordance with the laws of the International Criminal Court (ICC) and other applicable financial regulations, HHIDM may disclose one bilateral treaty solely for the purpose of facilitating financial transactions, provided that such disclosure is limited to the information required to comply with legal and regulatory obligations.
